<p><i>Prerequisites or conditions needed before beginning the Salah. If any of these conditions are not met, the Salah is not valid.</i></p>	<p><i>Acts required inside the Salah. If any of these pillars are left out intentionally, the Salah becomes invalid. If any are left out by mistake, the Rakah becomes invalid.</i></p>	<p><i>Acts required inside the Salah. If any of these acts are left out intentionally, the Salah becomes invalid. If any are left out by mistake, the Rakah becomes is invalid.</i></p>	<p><i>Acts that were performed by the Prophet in the Salah. It is highly recommended to perform these acts as the Prophet said "Pray as you see me pray."</i></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Islam</li> <li>➤ Sanity</li> <li>➤ Reaching the age of understanding</li> <li>➤ Removal of ritual impurity (Having Wudu)</li> <li>➤ Removal of Najasa (filth)</li> <li>➤ Covering the Awrah</li> <li>➤ Entering the prayer in it's proper time</li> <li>➤ Facing the Qiblah</li> <li>➤ Intention</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Standing, if one has the ability to do so</li> <li>➤ The opening Takbeer</li> <li>➤ Reciting Surat al-Fatihah</li> <li>➤ Bowing</li> <li>➤ Rising from bowing</li> <li>➤ Prostrating on all 7 limbs</li> <li>➤ Rising from prostration</li> <li>➤ Sitting between the two prostrations</li> <li>➤ Remaining tranquil during all acts</li> <li>➤ Maintaining the same sequence</li> <li>➤ The final Tashahud</li> <li>➤ Sitting for the final Tashahud</li> <li>➤ Sending Salat on the Prophet</li> <li>➤ The first Tasleem</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All the Takbeers except the opening Takbeer</li> <li>➤ Saying "Subhana Rabbi al-Adheem" while bowing</li> <li>➤ Saying "Sami'a Allahu Liman Hamidah"</li> <li>➤ Saying "Rabbana wa Lakal-Hamd"</li> <li>➤ Saying "Subhana Rabbi al-A'la" while prostrating</li> <li>➤ The first Tashahud</li> <li>➤ Sitting for the first Tashahud</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Raising the hands</li> <li>➤ Placing the right hand over the left hand</li> <li>➤ Placing the hands on the chest</li> <li>➤ The opening supplication</li> <li>➤ Saying Ameen after al-Fatihah</li> <li>➤ Quranic recitation after al-Fatihah</li> <li>➤ Reciting specific Surahs</li> <li>➤ Lengthening the first Rakah of the morning prayer</li> <li>➤ Beautifying your voice when reciting Quran</li> <li>➤ Reciting out loud in the first two Rakat of Fajr, Maghrib and Isha</li> <li>➤ Reciting in a moderate voice</li> <li>➤ Making the Takbeer upon moving from position to position</li> <li>➤ Manners of bowing and Dhikr</li> <li>➤ Manners of prostration and Dhikr</li> <li>➤ Supplications between the two prostrations</li> <li>➤ Sitting of rest (after second Sujood and before standing up again)</li> <li>➤ Supplications after the last Tashahud and before the Tasleem</li> <li>➤ The second Tasleem</li> <li>➤ Words of remembrance after the Tasleem</li> </ul>
<p><b>Missing a Pillar or Requirement by Mistake - Making Sujood as-Sahu</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If one misses a pillar or requirement by mistake and remembers while still in the same Rakah, one must perform the act immediately then make Sujood as-Sahu before Tasleem.</li> <li>• If one misses a pillar or requirement by mistake and remembers after finishing the Rakah or Salah, one must redo the entire Rakah then perform Sujood as-Sahu.</li> <li>• One performs Sujood as-Sahu before Tasleem if they mistakenly miss a pillar or requirement, and one performs Sujood as-Sahu after Tasleem if they mistakenly add a pillar or requirement.</li> </ul>
